1. Introduction

The SC08.MX3000 is a network AV Transceiver with HDMI input and output supporting up to 4K@60Hz 4:4:4, HDR. It is designed for HDMI transmission over IP networks with external audio and control signals using 10G switches, web browser or API's to control a variety of functions.

The transceiver provides one of the most advanced IP Streaming solutions on the market utilizing BlueRiverTM technology, bringing various IP/AV standards to work together as one. It combines a variety of 4K IP technologies and features one unified protocol using a simplified topology. Features include, uncompressed video with zero-latency from transmitter to receiver, seamless switching, Video wall, Multi-view, 1G Ethernet, IR, RS232, audio embedding/de-embedding, audio down-mixing, etc. It can be controlled by the IPA Manager software.

Compares with traditional HDBaseT matrix AV Switching. The SC08.MX3000 is a low cost, easy to install and flexible solution for high definition signal switching. It is ideal for distributing AV over 10 Gigabit Ethernet in enterprises and other large-scale installations.

1.1 About 10G Network

Unlike traditional AV extension technology, such as HDBaseT, where transmitters and receivers are connected point to point or joined together using custom matrix switches, the SC08.MX3000 is based on the inter compatible BlueRiverTM technology and connected using standard, off the shelf 10G Layer 2/3 network switches.

This architecture makes use of data packages that can be easily and independently routed to the desired unit. A variety of transmission modes is possible this way, from one unit to another unit (point to point) or one unit to many units (point to multipoint) or many units (multipoint to multipoint) with a software controllable video wall integration.

An added benefit of packet data transmission is that each signal type (video, audio, RS232, etc.) is routed independently and not necessarily to the same destination. For example, the HDMI video from a particular unit is routed to other 4 units, while the audio goes to all receivers in the setup. This unlimitedly scalable and independent signal routing enables multiple, scalable applications, including signal extension, splitting, switching, matrix routing and video wall functionality.



3.1 Front Panel




Number	Name	Function
1	Reset Button	Press and hold for 5 seconds to restore factory default settings.
2	Power	The LED illuminates RED when powered on.
3	Status	LED On: Normal LED Flashing/Off: Firmware Error or Hardware Error
4	Link	LED On: 10G Ethernet Connection Detected LED Off: No 10G Ethernet Detected
5	Video	The LED illuminates when HDMI is detected on input or output
6	USB	LED On: USB devices detected and transmitting data.
7	ENC	The LED illuminates GREEN when in ENC mode.
8	DEC	The LED illuminates GREEN when in DEC mode.
9	MODE	Press and hold for 5 seconds to switch between ENC and DEC.
10	USB Devices	Connect a keyboard, mouse or disk when in DEC mode.
11	USB Host	Connect to a PC when in ENC mode.

Selecting Encoder or Decoder


- 1. When powered on the ENC/DEC LED flashes for 15 seconds and then remains on indicating the selected mode. Press and hold the "MODE" button for 5 seconds to switch modes, the corresponding ENC/DEC LED flashes for 30 seconds and then remains on indicating a successful switch.
- 2. The "Show Me" mode can also be activated using the SC08.CTL100D Network Controller. When activated the corresponding LED illuminates.



6.0 Maintenance

Clean this unit with a soft, dry cloth. Never use alcohol, pint thinner of benzene to clean these devices.

6.1 Servicing
